FRAME 1

In order to maintain orderly control of all functions of the Army, it was necessary to establish certain standard and uniform procedures with regards to these functions. These approved procedures are set forth in numerous military publications.

The Army Regulation (AR) that governs military publications is AR 310-1. This regulation sets forth the General Policies for military publications and is, therefore, titled "General Policies".

To establish the same control of Army equipment, the "Technical Publications" system was set up. The Army Technical Publications give instructions for the correct operation, care, and maintenance for each individual item of equipment used.

FRAME 11

As you know Technical Bulletins (TB) are indexed in DA PAM 310-4.

TB's contain technical information on inspections, procedures, and/or techniques.

Technical Bulletins normally come down as a one time inspection or will be sent to units as needed until the Technical Manuals can be changed.

There are three types as listed below.

1. Immediate - complete before next flight, usually grounds aircraft.
2. Urgent - complete during specified time, restricts aircraft flight.
3. Normal - complete during specified time, normally next scheduled inspection.

There is one other type. The title is Technical Bulletin - Aviation (TB AVN). TB AVN's give additional information on all aircraft. As an example: TB AVN 23-16 tells when test flights should be completed, also by whom and when required.

FRAME 5

DA PAM 310-7 is the index to Modification Work Orders (MWO's) on all Army equipment.

Now, to put them all together.

First, if you want to know how to set up a file, look in General Policies AR 310-1.

To find the latest Administrative Publications to put in the file, look in DA PAM 310-1 (index).

You now have the paperwork completed. To know how to operate and care for your equipment, you must have the Technical Publications found in DA PAM 310-4 (index).

In order to keep equipment up to date, changes must be made. These changes are called Modifications. They are listed as Modification Work Orders (MWO) and are listed in DA PAM 310-7.

Check Page 13 and find the page numbers where MWO's can be found for helicopters.

FRAME 12

Modification Work Orders (MWO's) are indexed in DA PAM 310-7.

MWO's give us authentic and uniform instructions for the alternation and/or modification of equipment. As can be seen, by having MWO's we can keep all aircraft standard. When necessary, the appropriate kits are issued with the MWO.

There are two types.

1. Urgent - complete in specified time, usually restricts aircraft.
2. Normal - complete in specified time, usually next scheduled inspection.

All MWO's will be recorded on DA Form 2408-5, Equipment Modification Record. This form is carried in the aircraft log book.

MWO's are used as

- a. an interim until TM's are changed.
- b. a one time change to improve equipment.
