

4. USE OF "POSTAGE AND FEES PAID" ENVELOPES, LABELS, AND TAGS: Preprinted indicia envelopes, labels and tags are items of supply subject to policies and restrictions imposed by AFR 67-10. They must not be altered for personal use (AFR 182-15) (APO/2525) (2)
5. CLEANING FLUIDS: Gasoline, dope thinner, paint remover, and other highly flammable liquids will not be used for cleaning floors, equipment, hands or clothing. (BCEFD/2173) (2)
6. REPORTING FIRES: All fires, regardless of size, will be immediately reported to the Base Fire Department by the most expeditious means. Even though fire has been extinguished, it must be reported. Ref Section C, CRBR 92-1. (BCEFD/2173) (2)
7. EARLY RELEASE PROGRAM-FIRST TERM AIRMEN: All regular first term airmen with a date of separation during the period Nov 68 through Sep 69 must report to Personnel (R&S) immediately to sign a "Statement of Intent-Early Release". (CBPO-R&S/2507) (2)
