B. 2/11 ACR continued operations with two (2) cavalry troops and one (1) OFCON RF Co conducting ground recon north of Nui Be Mountain. This operation was in conjunction with elements of 2-8 Cav working to the south in the Nui Be Mountain itself. 2/11 also continued security operations for the 60th LCC vic of Vo Dat/Xo Xu.

C. E Trp (-) continued security operations at Vo Dat for the 60th LCC with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd platoons. The Prov plt (4th plt) secured fire base Riviera. On 1 February the 1st and 4th platoons exchanged missions.

D. F Trp (-) continued recon opns NW of Nui Be Mountain with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd plt's. The 4th platoon conducted security opns and maintenance at FSB Bolan.

E. G Trp (-) continued recon opns N of Nui Be Mountain with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd platoons. The 4th platoon provided security for FSB Donna.

F. 140th RF Co continued recon operation NE of Nui Be Mountain with 3 platoons.

G. How Btry continued DS for the Squadron, with 3 guns each at FSB Bolan and FSB Donna.

#### H. Significant Activities.

(1) On 301130 January 2/G Trp DM engaged two (2) NVA vic YS829939. Results 1 NVA KIA and 1 SKS CIA.

(2) On 301350 January 2/G Trp found a cache with a total of 17,930 lbs of flour, and 1200 lbs of sugar at YS836935.

(3) On 301610 January Sqdn Blues found a cache with a total of 22,000 lbs of flour at YS837938.

(4) On 310840 January an F Trp AA detonated at YS914912. Results 1 VC KIA and 1 M-16 CIA.

(5) On 04 February 2/11 ACR conducted a cordon and search opn of hamlets near OP4 on QL-1. Units participating were F Trp, G Trp, 140th RF Co, HHT, and National Police. Results were 41 detainees.


#### 2. Supporting Activities:

A. Arty fired a total of 55 missions during the period for total of 433 HE rounds 36 WP and 61 Illumination rounds.

#### B. Civil Affairs:

(1) During the period 3 Medcaps were conducted. On the morning of 4 February in conjunction with cordon opns vic of OP4 a total of 105 persons were treated for minor injuries/illnesses.
