C. During the period 2/11 ACR conducted operations in western Binh Tuy Province north and south of QL-1, in eastern Long Khan Province south of QL-1.

D. E Trp (-): Conducted ground reconnaissance in western Binh Tuy Province north of QL-1. On 15 March conducted tactical move south across QL-1 to conduct ground reconnaissance/screening operations north & east of Nui Be Mountain Complex. The 2nd plt continued maintenance and training at Battle Station.

E. F Trp (-): Continued OPCON 1/5 Cav. 4th platoon continued to secure FSB Bolan.

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F. G Trp (-): Continued ground reconnaissance/screening operations in support 2/8 Cav in western Binh Tuy Province south of QL-1 and north of Nui Be Mountain Complex. 4th platoon continued to secure FSB Donna.

G. 919th Eng Detachment: Continued to operate Squadron water point to provide general support of the Squadron from FSB Bolan and Battle Station.

H. How Btry: 1 section continued direct support from FSB Donna throughout the period. On 15 March one (1) section conducted tactical road march from FSB Bolan to establish FSB Judy vic YT659040. Provided direct support from FSB Judy for remainder of period.

I. Significant Highlights: 171155H, VS839941 G Troop found a cache of flour consisting of 200x50 kilo bags or a total of 22,000 pounds. This was the same type of flour found by G Troop in January near the same vicinity. Markings on the bags indicated the ^{manu-}facturers to be the "Noyon Flour Company", San Francisco, California. Documents found on a VC KIA by 2-8 Cav on 18 March indicated that this cache find by 2-11 Cav was causing the MR-7 Headquarters great concern. ^{And that 2/11 operations in general were causing MR-7 Headquarters concern} The document indicated that the cache belonged to elements of C10 Purchasing and Requisitioning Company. They also indicated there was another cache in the area the enemy hoped to evacuate before the "tanks" found it too. The document stated that the particular cache found had been earmarked to be distributed to the 3 Bn/33rd NVA Regiment. The primary function of the C10 Purchasing and Requisitioning Company is to provide supplies to units operating under MR-7 and Ba Long Province Control. S2 believes continued efforts in the same area will possibly expose further cache sites and it will definitely cause continued difficulties for the MR-7 Headquarters in the Nui Be area.
