



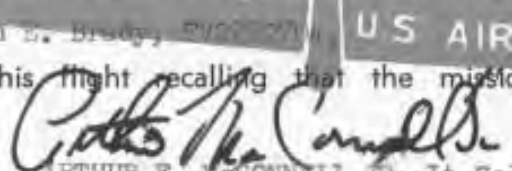
SPECIAL ORDER
