Tou Lou says that the Viet minh held roughly the same terrain during the Indochina war as they do now and that he conducted much the same type of action then as is being done now

1955 Tou Lou returned 200 of his weapons to Touby who needed them for another area, but did not return any of his weapons to the Lao Govt - nor was he asked to

1955 - 1960 continued his duties as Naikong of Phou Do - Mao areas in XKV were broken down as follows;

Naikong Jia Sang (later Chao Moun))

zones 6a, 11 and Nong Het, XKV area

Naikong Yeu Pao (now comdr 6a)

in charge of the gov't office in XKV

Naikong Neng Thong (now comdr 6b)

zones 1, 2a, 7

1960; sent by Vang Pao to organize Phou San and Phou Vieng zones - maintained contact with Angry 9 radio with Paksane and Vang Pao

1961; promoted to Sub/Lt

1962; promoted to Lt. and moved to Vetn to handle Vang Pao's civilian problems - continues to act as Vang Pao's top advisor on all non - military problems

there are three married sisters - one is Vang Pao's fifth wife

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Tou Lou stated that the Lao and French never made an accurate census of even Xieng Khouang Province - requiring that the Naikongs supply only the number of men over 21 in each tasseng. This has caused confusion, for his area was officially accredited with 4000 men and in time it was sometimes thought to mean 4000 total. Actually, there were about 12,000 Meo under Tou Lou's control (Lao and Lao-theung came under the Lao). Similarly, the entire province was listed as having 60,000 Meo men - the actual total was about 3 times as many.

Tou Lou commented that most of the Meo who have become PL have done so less out of political conviction than out of hatred of a particular Meo or Meo family who happened to be allied with Vang Pao. For example, Xiong Ma Moua, the Chao Moung Meo in the Khang Khay area, turned PL only after an argument with Geu Pao, now the comdr of zone 4c, when the two were together in Moung Moc (zone 1c). Although both of the same family, they disagreed over the control of the area and a hot argument ensued. Tou Lou is certain that this is the only reason why Xiong Ma Moua went to the PL.
