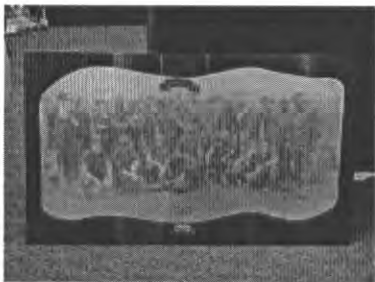
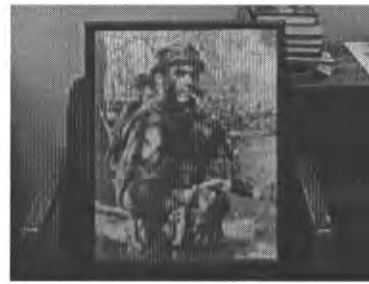
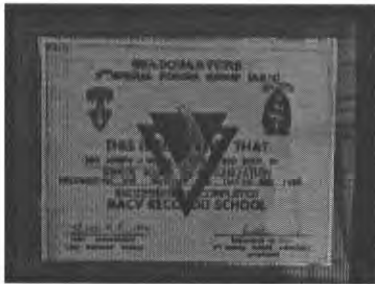

First Sergeant Joseph J. Welsh, USA [Ret.] served with the 1st Battalion, 101st Airborne Division and Company E, Long Range Patrol (LRP), 20th Infantry First Field Force Vietnam (IFFY) in the Republic of Vietnam. He held many different positions such as; Radar/ Recon Vehicle Operator, Infantry Squad Leader and Platoon Sergeant (SGT), Long Range Patrol Team Leader, Infantry Operations and Intelligence SGT, Special Forces Medic, Drill SGT, Reconnaissance Instructor, Noncommissioned Officer (NCO) Academy Instructor, Civil Affairs and Psychological Operations Advisor, Interpreter, First SGT, and Special Forces Senior SGT and received numerous awards and certificates during his twenty-five years in the United States Army. This Collection contains information about 1SGT Welsh and photographs from his service in Vietnam.

E Long Range Patrol (LRP) 20th Infantry First Field Force Vietnam (IFFV), RVN, HQ, Co. 3rd BN 325th INF, 82nd ABN DIV, 7th INF DIV, U.S. Army INF Training (TNG) BDE, Ft. Benning, GA, XVIII ABN Corps, Ft. Bragg, NC, Joint Allied Task Force, Izmir, Turkey, 96th Civil Affairs BN, United States Special Operations Command (USSOCOM), Ft. Bragg, NC; 1st BN 1st Special Forces Group (SFG) ABN, Okinawa, Japan, 3rd BN 1st SFG, ABN, Ft. Lewis, WA, U.S. Army Special Operations Command (USASOCOM), and the U.S. Army John F. Kennedy Special Warfare Center and School, Ft. Bragg, NC.

His decorations and awards include; the Bronze Star Medal with a "V" device (valor) and 1 Oak Leaf Cluster, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (3rd award), Army Commendation Medal (4th award); Joint Service Achievement Award, Army Achievement Medal (4th award), Joint Meritorious Unit Award, Meritorious Unit Commendation, Army Good Conduct Medal (6th award), National Defense Service Medal (2nd award), Vietnam Service Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal with 2 Bronze Service Stars, Humanitarian Service Medal, NCO Professional Development Ribbon with Numeral 3, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon (2nd award), Republic of Vietnam Civil Actions Medal Unit Citation, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Kuwait Liberation Medal (K) - Kuwait Liberation Medal (SA), Combat Infantryman Badge, Master Parachutist Badge, Pathfinder Badge, Drill Sergeant Identification Badge, MACV Recondo Badge, XVIII Airborne Corps Recondo Badge, Philippine Army Master Parachutist Badge, Royal Thai Army Master Airborne Wings, Expert Marksmanship Badge with Rifle and Pistol Bars, 5 Combat Patches, and 3 Overseas Bars.

1SG (R) Welsh now resides in San Antonio, Texas. He is an active member of the 75th Ranger Regiment Assn. Inc., Co E (LRP) 20th INF ABN/Co C (Ranger) 75th INF ABN Assn., the Alamo Silver Wings Airborne Assn., the Veterans of Foreign Wars - Sam Houston Post 76, the Disabled American Veterans, and the Professional Association of Diving Instructors. He is currently a 100% disabled veteran from injuries and illness incurred during his career. His hobbies include playing the Blues harmonica and riding his Harley Davidson Springer. He has 2 children, Michael and Shelly, and is currently married to the former Dr. Carrie Lorraine Chesser.
