There are 39 individuals in his company. The entire company is located mainly center mass of grid 3936 on a trail west of FSB Snuffy at YU 299333, the trail is mined by claymores and chicoms. This trail splits at the red ball and runs generally northsouth. A unit possibly in the area is Z28 Sappers. The Chieu Hoi has worked with Z28 in the past. The mining of the trail mentioned is for the purpose of early warning. The man named the 3rd Co K-28 as the unit which mortared FSB Snuffy when 1/12 Cav was there. When U.S. troops went into Cam- bodia the K-28 was operating near the border. The U.S. activity forced the K-28 to go into Cambodia to obtain food. They brought no arms back into South Vietnam. The unit scrounged food during the U.S. activities in Cambodia. The company has been reduced since the Cav entered Cambodia from 100 men to 39 men due to desertion, lack of food, sickness, and frag wounds. The man interrogated has</p>			INITIALS
