 by the individual who fired. Recon found this after
 following an azimuth given them in the direction
 of the ground to air fire. There was 01 piece
 of paper in the pack with flints. This is being
 backlogged. Paper listed 17 names of NVA or VC
 (negative montanyards) with type weapons and number
 of rds and number of grenades they had negative
 date. Paper may have been used to light fires

 cells (homemade flashlight batteries, 03 bars
 soap, 03 C-Ration accessory packs, 01 bag of
