This letter is in regards to your letter of 24 April 1971 concerning the status of orders on a Distinguished Flying Cross and Army Commendation Medal for SP5 David C. Martin.

The records here at battalion level only go back as far as a year for awards and decorations so there are no records for 1969. The awards and decorations at Division were checked and it was found that SP5 Martin had been awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for action on 10 July 1969. The general order number for this award is 14771 dated 13 December 1969. There was no record of SP5 Martin having received an Army Commendation Medal.

A letter has been written to the United States Army Personnel Support Center, ATTN: AGDE-RC, Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana 46249. A records check has been requested for SP5 Martin's Army Commendation Medal. The Army Personnel Support Center will send you the results of that check. Also it has been requested that the personnel center send you information you need for SP5 Martin's Distinguished Flying Cross.
