TRANSFER OF CONTROL (Items 1, 2, & 3.)

1. ENROUTE (report to follow) (Initial contact compulsory)
 - a. ID
 - b. Position (Name of Fix)

2. ENROUTE (No report to follow) (Initial contact non-compulsory)
 - a. ID
 - b. ETA Next reporting point
 - c. Altitude

3. ENROUTE (RADAR Environment) (Ref CLIP II, Pg 73)
 - a. ID
 - b. Altitude

4. ENROUTE REPORT (Includes departing an enroute holding point)
 - a. ID
 - b. Position
 - c. Time
 - d. Altitude
 - e. Type of flight plan (To FSS only)
 - f. ETA next reporting point
 - g. Name only of next succeeding reporting point
 - h. Remarks

5. ENROUTE (On request to report PASSING or BY a fix)
 - a. ID
 - b. Position
 - c. Time

6. OTHER REPORTS

- a. Initial arrival over approach fix with approach clearance.
 - (1) ID
 - (2) Name of fix
 - (3) Time
 - (4) Altitude
 - (5) Outbound

- b. Departing an altitude
 - (1) ID
 - (2) Departing ALTITUDE
 - (3) Time

- c. Departing an approach fix (After holding on other than the published approach course)

Same as item 6a.

- d. Station passage inbound
 - (1) ID
 - (2) Fix
 - (3) Time
 - (4) Inbound

- e. Missed approach
 - (1) ID
 - (2) Missed approach
 - (3) Time
 - (4) Remarks (intentions)

- f. Arriving at a holding fix
