Annual Loss of Licence Insurance

We thank you for your letter dated the 19th June advising us that you have now left Air America and are now employed by Great China Airlines and our records have been noted accordingly.

We would confirm that your insurance was renewed when you were with Air America in the sum of U.S.\$72,000 for a period of 12 months up to the 31st March, 1975.

You will appreciate, of course, that your insurance was arranged under a group scheme and arranged through your previous employers and this insurance is only available to Air crew of Air America. However, we have approached Underwriters and they have agreed to continue your insurance up to the date of expiry. We regret we shall be unable to renew this insurance after the 1st April next year but we can offer you an alternative scheme and we will be writing to you concerning that well before the expiry date of your present insurance.
