I feel so proud to be an American after president Bush, speech before the congress on Thursday September 20, 2001 I have not felt this good since prior to joining the army back in 1968, this man has more courage than any other leader I can think of he is a kind and simple man greatly under rated by many but I do know one thing about George W, he is a man of his words, he means what he said and said what he means, he will get those terrorists for what they did to our brave american citizens, I love this man with all my heart he has such great courage, my cousins sister Marie was on the 40th floor of One World Trade Center when the first jet hit, she along with fellow workers tried to escape they had only four separate staircases and the first she ran to was locked precious minutes passed for life the jet hit between the 60th and 80th floors jet fuel burning all the way down to the 40th floor an elevator my cousin told me hit the 40th floor it was full of people on fire that were screaming and burning alive, finally my cousin found another staircase and ran out as hundreds of brave cops and firemen and woman running up the stairs, Marie made it to the ground floor and while she was running away from the building she witnessed dozens of poor people on fire and jumping holding of hands to the deaths some 80-floors below, as she got two blocks away the second jet hit tower number two, a persons head and torso came down in front of her she is still in a state of shock and will greatly suffer (PTSD) from all that she saw she said many people in wheelchairs died and burned alive, some 45-minutes later if all that was not enough the tower came totally down one could hear the thousands of people screams of those about to die, I, am so enraged I want the president to make sure all those terrorist die I, am willing to die for our country if it means killing them I, am in a great emotional state of shock severe (PTSD) and having talking with many of our fellow veterans who lost family and friends we as veterans want action help us by supporting our very brave president I will give my life for this man, I' am crying right now it's so hard for me to write you this letter please understand spread the work we all need to support our president, God keep you safe and well God always be with you may you feel better from your stroke and severe diabetes I know how sad your also feeling right now.
