Reference your letter of March 30th, concerning the tentative Air America movie that is contemplated.

Phil Jennings first brought this to our attention last year and it was described in the trade papers as a spoof of the CIA's private airline based on Christopher Robbin's book. This plot, in view of Hollywood's past record, is distressing to the membership but your fears of a plot depicting us as operating a drug smuggling airline is carrying the joke a little too far.

Quoting from a law reference: "As important as any freedom to which you are entitled is freedom from unwarranted, untruthful attacks on your character. This kind of attack, if made in the presence of other people, constitutes defamation, for which you are entitled to nominal or punitive damages, as the case may be. If you are defamed orally, you have been slandered. If the defamation is in writing and shown to or seen by someone else, you have been libeled. ----- Libel is permanent as long as the letter, magazine article or book in which the words appear continues to exist, and the damages awarded are therefore usually larger. Generally speaking, defamatory statements made over radio or television are now considered libelous rather than slanderous."

If this proposed movie about Air America depicts us in an untruthful manner, the Air America Club will certainly entertain a motion to sponsor a class action lawsuit against the producers and others involved.

Jim, we would appreciate a correct address for the producers so we may advise them of this fact in writing.
