PROGRAM:

1345	Guests arrive, proceed to seats. VIPs escorted to reserved seats. Music selection by Navy Band.
1400	Master of Ceremonies, Vice Admiral Thor Hanson, USN (Ret.) Commanding Officer, USS Frank E. Evans, 1966 - 1968, welcomes assembled guests.
1405	Presentation Of Colors - Naval Ceremonial Guard (NDW) National Anthem - U.S. Navy Band
1410	Invocation - U.S. Navy Chaplain
1415	VADM Hanson - Brief opening remarks - Introduces special guests and introduces guest of honor and featured speaker.
1420	Senator John W. Warner (invited) - remarks
1435	VADM Hanson introduces association representative to read names of 74 lost crewmen. Navy Band plays Navy Hymn and other suitable background music or muffled drumroll.
1445	VADM Hanson introduces Mr. J.C. Campbell, President, U.S.S. Frank E. Evans Association, to officiate at unveiling of plaque with Senator Warner. Plaque unveiling ceremony.
1450	Benediction and prayer by Navy Chaplain. Taps by Navy Bugler.
1455	VADM Hanson closes program. Navy Band - upbeat music, Anchor's Away, etc.
