SUBJ: Ivy Strategy

Rob Hager informed me that he's changing his approach with Ivy. Senator Daschle has agreed to write a letter to the administration requesting that Clinton ask the Solicitor General's Office to file an amicus brief on Ivy. He wants to know if you have any contacts that could open a door to the administration (i.e. Kerrey or Bonior writing to the administration). The Solicitor General's Office would greatly increase the chances of the case being heard.

With regard to the AOCC signing on to the brief, we need to get letters from the member organizations on their letterhead, agreeing to sign on to the brief. (I wish he would have told me this earlier.) Once the brief comes out it will be easier to sign on more groups with many already listed on the cover.

As a separate matter, are you still interested in finding out from Rob if the AOCC needs to be incorporated in order to file or does filing as organizations answer that question?
