



A SUPPLEMENT to "An Act making appropriations for the support of the State Government and the several public purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993 and regulating the disbursement thereof," passed June 30, 1992 (P.L.1992, c.40).

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.1992, c.40, there is appropriated out of the General Fund the following sum for the purpose specified:

67 DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS' AFFAIRS  
80 Special Government Services  
83 Services to Veterans  
3610 Veterans' Programs Support

50-3610 Veterans' Outreach and Assistance.....\$50,000  
Special Purpose:

Agent Orange Commission ..... (\$50,000)

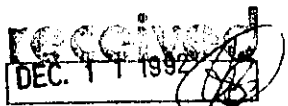
2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill appropriates \$50,000 to the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs to pay for the administrative expenses of the Agent Orange Commission. This appropriation will allow the commission to continue its operations until the end of the current fiscal year (FY 1993). Without it, the commission will be forced to cease operations on January 13, 1993.
