I think that if anything positive happens for Vietnam Veterans and their families, it will be coming from the Agent Orange Coordinating Council.

You and I both know of what Agent Orange, and the unwanted by-product, Dioxin, has done to our Veterans and their families, and something should be done about it, and it should be done, yesterday.

If it is at all possible, I would like to be a full member of the Agent Orange Coordinating Council, to do what I can, to get this issue resolved for the Vietnam Veteran, and his/her family members. I trust that you will let me know on that.

The enclosed that came from Mr. Jan Scruggs of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund, is being sent to you, to request that you include it in your next mailing out to the Coordinating Council, as I feel that everyone involved with Vietnam Veterans, should be made aware of what will be happening at "The Wall", from 7th November, 1992, to 11th November, 1992. I trust that your office will help "get the word out".


