At a meeting of the New Jersey State Council, Vietnam Veterans of America, Inc. on Sunday, January 17, a motion was unanimously passed to join the fight against the ocean dumping of Dioxin contaminated sludge from Newark Bay. The motion gave the authority to the State Council to take any and all actions that they may deem necessary to prevent Dioxin contamination from affecting other generations

The motion was immediately joined by the New York State Council, Vietnam Veterans of America, Inc. who's Officers were in attendance at the meeting in New Jersey.

The President of the New York State Council, John Greco and the President of the New Jersey State Council, Gary Wall, said jointly: " The New York and New Jersey State Councils will not Stand Idly by while another generation is exposed to Dioxins. We, as Vietnam Veterans, Know all to well the severe health impact and birth defects caused by exposure to Dioxin in Vietnam. There is little we can do to reverse our own exposure, but we can do everything in our power to prevent another generation from experiencing the adverse health effects caused by Dioxin in the food chain and water.
