Our firm is assisting Mr. Goro Nakamura who is producing a television documentary/special for Television Asahi of Japan. Some time ago, Mr. Nakamura worked on a special report on Agent Orange and the effects on Vietnam veterans and their families. Now, they are interested in interviewing the same individuals to see how they are doing and the impact on the next generation; the children of these veterans, examining the issues and recent scientific reports and studies.

According to Mr. Nakamura's fax to us, he spoke with you in Bangkok, and that you indicated that you might be available for an additional interview in the U.S. Mr. Nakamura would also like to speak with other members of your family, if they would agree to be interviewed.

For this program, Mr. Nakamura would like to do an on-camera interview with you sometime between November 4th and November 10th in the Washington, D.C. area. If this time frame is impossible, would sometime between November 12th and 20th fit into your schedule? In addition to this interview, and the possible talk with your family members, he would like to receive permission to accompany you with a camera person, to record some of your activities (depending on your schedule during the time frame)- perhaps covering a speech or meetings with veterans or whatever. He is especially interested in filming some of the Veterans Day activities around the Nation's Capital.

He has requested we contact you on his behalf to help him make all the necessary arrangements for his trip to the U.S. as well as obtaining the necessary Park Service permits etc. He has asked that we convey this request to you first so that all arrangements can be made at your convenience should you grant him the time. All other interviews and filming schedules will be set after any and all scheduling with you and your family has been completed.

For your reference, I am also sending a copy of our company's information sheet. We will provide all interpreting services and facilitate all communications, including translations, for Mr. Nakamura and Television Asahi.


