I have read that the Pentagon plans to delete funds for F-14D in 1991 and that a "stop-work order" may be issued for F-14's currently in production.

With the decision to cancel the A-12 program, there is, in my judgement, an urgent need to continue production and future procurement of the F-14D. It is still the world's best fighter aircraft and critical to the continuing viability of carrier aviation.

I have no financial interest in this matter.

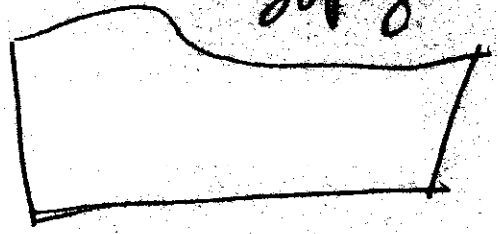
