Mr. and Mrs. Parker were contacted in response to their letter to the former CNO, Elmo Zumwalt Jr., and stated that a similar inquiry addressed to the Commanding Officer, USS BOULDER (LST 1190) had been recently answered to their satisfaction both through written and telephonic correspondence with the BOULDER. Liaison with Executive Officer, BOULDER indicates that SNM is presently being processed for discharge based on unsuitability. Mr. and Mrs. Darwin ^{Parker} feel that their son was unable to adjust to shipboard life and that a discharge from the naval service would be in his best interests.
