Dear Mr. Ferrer:

Admiral Holloway appreciated receiving your letter and asked that I reply in his behalf.

Your desire to reenlist in the Navy is appreciated. In order to expedite your possible reenlistment, you should contact the Navy recruiter located at Subic Bay. This recruiter will be happy to assist you in submitting an application as well as answering any questions you may have. You will be required to present the recruiter with a copy of your (DD-214 Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge) at the time you apply for reenlistment. Please note that application to the Navy recruiter constitutes a formal request for reenlistment and is necessary because of the mandatory pre-reenlistment physical examination and other processing required for a member desiring to reenlist after being separated from the Navy for more than ninety days. Upon receipt of the complete application, the recruiter will either approve or disapprove your application for reenlistment. If the Chief of Naval Personnel's approval is required to authorize your reenlistment, the recruiter will forward the application for determination. You may be assured your application will be given every consideration and you will be promptly notified of the final decision.

This letter should not be construed as commenting either favorably or unfavorably on your chances of being authorized to reenlist. Such a decision can only be made after processing has been completed.
