YNC Kaufman contacted SNM in reply to all the letters he wrote to various members of Congress and CNO (ZUMWALT). The situation concerning SNM's request was discussed in detail with SNM. SNM desires a transfer "away from Marines for good." Lack of viable evidence on the part of SNM to cause this type action to be effected and the need to maintain stability by having personnel complete assigned tours precludes transfer at this time.


