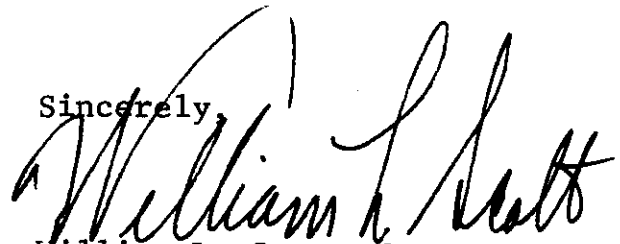
Dear Admiral Zumwalt:
