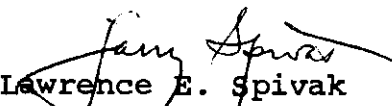
Dear Elmo:

Dear Larry,

Many thanks for your letter of December 30 concerning the Evans and Novak story. Since you were the very first to suggest Virginia politics to me, I am delighted to give you a report of where I am.

I have been doing the lecture circuit and, in addition, serving as a visiting university professor--formally designated so at Vanderbilt and informally at the University of Pennsylvania.

I have been approached by others about running in Virginia as the story indicated but, as my subsequent statement indicated, I have made no decision. My primary problem is that I am so fully enmeshed giving birth to my book that I haven't been able to do the hundreds of things one ought to do in order to gain a basis for decision making.

I am interested in a number of things beginning in July when I have completed the book.

Mouza and I are wondering if the Spivaks might enjoy dropping by for cocktails on either Sunday the 5th or Sunday the 12th of January about 5ish so that we can carry on the conversation and expand the friendship.
