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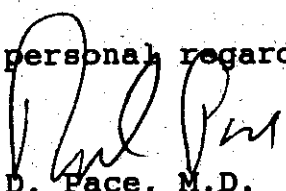

I have sent your materials along to my distinguished son-in-law, Dr. Michael Coppola.

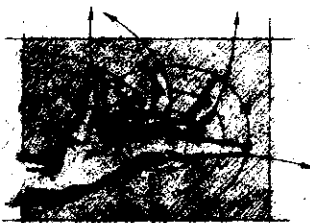

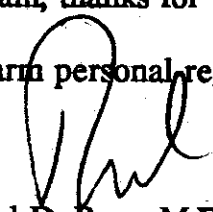
Thank you so much for sending your book On Watch. I think this is quite a book, and I plan to start reading it in the near future. I particularly appreciate having your autograph in the book.
