Dear Admiral,

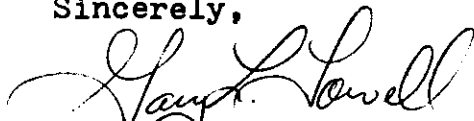
I hope that this finds you well and somewhat rested after all your travels. It was nice of you to write, but let me assure you that the pleasure was all mine.
