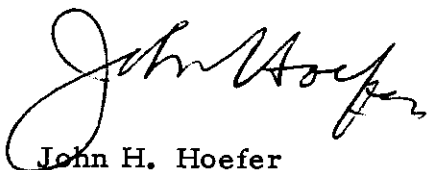

Thank you very much for including me in the luncheon for Admiral Zumwalt. He is still another native son of San Francisco of whom we can be most proud.

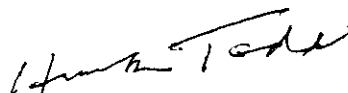

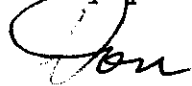
I can't tell you how flattered I was to be included in that fine group of Californians at luncheon this week.
