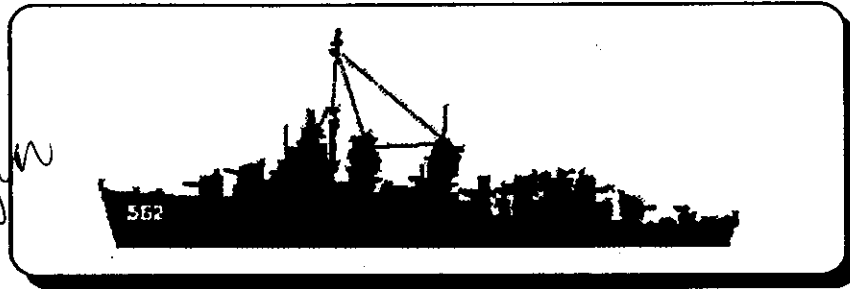

It's time for the 17th U.S.S. Robinson Reunion which will be held on September 4, 5, 6 and 7th at the WYNDHAM GARDENS, 765 Eisenhower Blvd., Harrisburg, PA 17111. Make your room reservations by calling 1-800-253-0238 or 1-717-558-9500. The room rate is only \$64.00 per day plus 6% tax (1 - 4 people). All room reservations must be made with the hotel before August 1, 1997 to get the reunion rate. When making your room reservation, don't forget to tell them you are with the U.S.S. Robinson Reunion. The cost of the room includes a hot breakfast **BUFFET** each day. The hotel offers in-room coffee makers, free daily paper, coin laundry, exercise room, whirlpool/sauna, and outdoor pool. The hotel also has a daily guest appreciation in the lounge. Treat is "Chef's Choice". Free airport shuttle is available. The hotel has a call phone near luggage handling. 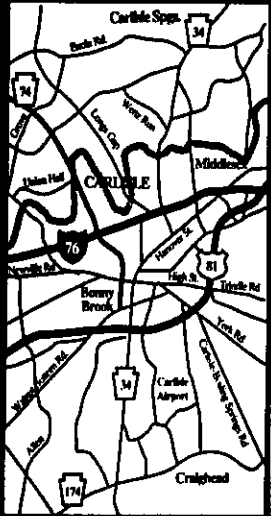

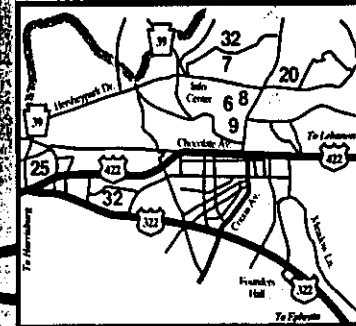
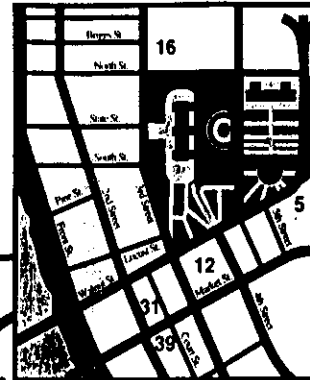
