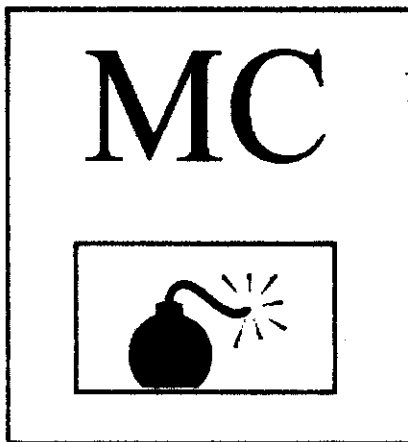

15 August

52 years ago today, we invaded Southern France.

51 years ago today, VJ day--the surrender of the Japan was announced.

On October 20, 52 years ago, we invaded the Island of Leyte and began preparation to fight the Battle of Leyte Gulf. Your old Granddad was on the USS ROBINSON, DD 562.

On October 24, 52 years ago, the Battles of Leyte Gulf, Surigao Straits, Samar and Cape Engano began. Granddad served as combat evaluator on board USS ROBINSON which led a division of destroyers and torpedo attacks against the Japanese fleet coming up Surigao Straits.

6 November 1942

On this date, those of us deployed in the Pacific War were delighted to learn that the amphibious invasion of North Africa had commenced because this meant that soon after the defeat of the axis powers, reinforcements would reach us to wage the war against the Japanese.

12-15 November 1942

The Navy battles to save Guadalcanal took place against the Japanese fleet.

20 November 1943

On this date, our marine amphibious assault seized the Island of Tarawa in the center Pacific.

25 November 1943

On this date in 1943 Captain Arleigh A. Burke's Destroyer Squadron 23 sank five Japanese destroyers in the Battle of Cape St. George.

Being in San Francisco repairing my destroyer, I missed this thrill.

27 November 1950

On this date, the battle of the Chosin Reservoir began from which the Marines were forced to "advance to the rear" notwithstanding battleship gunfire support to help them.
