

## The Soviet Grand Strategy

The outline of Soviet grand strategy for the rest of the 20th century is emerging.

has the free world at a great disadvantage. Many Americans now know that most civilian defense officials <sup>and</sup> senior military who have been to the jets and war games are deeply concerned

about the Soviet march to strategic nuclear and  
conventional military superiority.

Smaller number of Americans are aware of the way  
in which the Soviet Union, under the <sup>deterrence</sup> umbrella of its  
strategic nuclear superiority, is moving boldly to wield  
an effective system for applying conventional military power to  
win its objectives around the globe.

Simply stated the Soviet Union is moving to replace  
the great commercial and seapower system which  
first the British Empire and then the US <sup>seeks to</sup> maintain the basic  
stability of world peace and prosperity. The Soviet Union sees  
itself as the center of a rising Soviet Empire.  
Its heartland in Eurasia will rule. This new empire  
through a new and unique system of alliances in  
which the outdated ideas of colonialism will be replaced
