Dear Admiral Zumwalt,

Thank you for your letter of August 5th, and for bringing me up to date on your trip to Vietnam. I would like to work with you to do what we can with the Sultan of Brunei. As you know, he travels all over the world, and not too long ago bought the Helmsley Palace in New York City. I understand that sometimes it is easier to meet with him in New York than it is in Borneo. Your window of one day to meet with him in Borneo does not sound very promising, but perhaps you will be lucky. I hope so.

Would you please keep me posted on your successes and failures, and would you put me in touch with the U.S. Ambassador to Brunei and the Ambassador to the United States from Brunei?

My objective is, of course, to obtain a gift from Brunei to the United States Navy Memorial, and secondly, to help us coordinate some ceremony remembering the surrender of Borneo from the Japanese back to the allies some fifty years ago.

As I mentioned to you, Charlie Stetson, who was the Lieutenant who drove the Admiral to the mainland of Borneo to accept the surrender, will be in Borneo in January of this year. If we could arrange some type of ceremony, either in January or in August, Charlie would be more than happy to participate. Charlie is quite a generous man, and chairs three family foundations.

I look forward to seeing you at the Board meeting and Dinner on the 17th.
