Subject: Request for Appointment with the Sultan of Brunei

DEAR ADMIRAL ZUMWALT:

I HAVE YOUR FAX LETTER OF NOVEMBER 8TH, ENCLOSING THE LETTERS FROM WILLITS SAWYER, EXPRESSING HIS INTEREST IN MEETING WITH THE SULTAN OF BRUNEI.

I SUGGEST THAT MR. SAWYER WRITE TO PEHIN NAWAWI, PRIVATE AND CONFIDENTIAL SECRETARY TO THE SULTAN, DESCRIBING IN DETAIL THE PURPOSE OF HIS DESIRED MEETING, AND ENCLOSING FULL BIOGRAPHIC DATA ON HIMSELF AND ADMIRAL STETSON, WITH PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO THEIR ROLE IN THE LIBERATION OF BORNEO. HE MIGHT ALSO INVITE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE EMBASSY OF BRUNEI IN WASHINGTON TO VISIT THE NAVY MEMORIAL, AND EXPLAIN TO HIM OR HER HOW BRUNEI MIGHT BE HIGHLIGHTED AT THE MEMORIAL SHOULD A CONTRIBUTION BE FORTHCOMING.

THIS SAID, YOU AND MR. SAWYER SHOULD BE AWARE THAT THE SULTAN IS CONSTANTLY ASKED TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO HUNDREDS OF WORTHY CAUSES. I WOULD NOT HOLD OUT MUCH HOPE THAT MR. SAWYER AND THE ADMIRAL WOULD BE SUCCESSFUL IN OBTAINING AN AUDIENCE. SHOULD THEY DECIDE TO VISIT BRUNEI, HOWEVER, I WOULD BE PLEASED TO MEET THEM IF THEY CARED TO CALL AT THE EMBASSY.

I AM SORRY THAT I CANNOT BE OF MORE ASSISTANCE.
