Dear Admiral (Ret.) Zumwalt:

Thank you for your fax letter of June 14, 1994, requesting assistance in arranging a courtesy call on the Sultan of Brunei.

Earlier this week, I received a similar request by E-mail from our Embassy in Jakarta. On checking with the Sultan's appointments Secretary, I was told that your request is "in queue" and that once the Sultan returns to Brunei later this month, he will consider your request.

As I indicated previously to Jakarta, I suggest that if you do not hear anything by the end of July, you notify Ambassador Tull and request that she raise your request with His Majesty.
