Dear Admiral Zumwalt:

I have your fax of July 20 confirming your request for assistance in arranging an audience with the Sultan of Brunei.

Mr. James Bell left for my information your previous communications with us on this subject. I contacted Palace Protocol to initiate action on this request. We are now following up with the Palace. I will be in touch with you as soon as I have any firm word.

I note that you have specifically asked for an appointment on September 8. I might caution that the Sultan travels frequently and it might be difficult to pin down an appointment for one specific date. If you have some flexibility something might be more easily arranged.

On a personal note, I have visited the Navy Memorial in Washington, DC and think it is a fine undertaking. I hope we will be able to arrange an appointment for you.
