I am planning a trip to Vietnam in September and would like to include Brunei in my schedule.

I am writing to you at the suggestion of Laurence J. Printie of His Majesty The Sultan's Flight to see if you can assist me in arranging a courtesy call on The Sultan. I would like to discuss the possibility of The Sultan supporting the United States Navy Memorial in Washington, DC. I have a deep interest in visiting Brunei due to my days in World War II where I was an officer on the destroyer USS Robinson assigned to the amphibious force that liberated Brunei.

On May 20 I sent a letter to the Brunei Chancellory in Washington with the above information including my biography.

I would appreciate anything you can do to facilitate my having a visit with The Sultan. As my flight arrangements are presently, September 8 would be the best date for me to visit Brunei.
