Dear Admiral Zumwalt:

Last year the Political Science Department initiated a new type of undergraduate course in which persons who have had major public policy positions share with faculty the teaching role. ~~Among those who were guests in the course last year were Elliot Richardson, George Reedy, George Romney, Robert Strauss, George Bush and A. Philip Odeen (course outline enclosed).~~

This year we are giving two such courses, one of which is on The American Presidency. We would like you to conduct a class on The President as Commander-in-Chief. The course will consider the Office of the Presidency primarily in the last four administrations. It has been our experience that this type of class is a pedagogical success and the students gain greatly from the experience. If you are able to accept, it might be advisable for us to come down and talk to you. We will call you within the next week or so.

The class is held each Wednesday afternoon, beginning in mid-September and running until December. The format of each class is for the guest to lecture for approximately one hour, followed by commentary from a faculty member and then questions by students. A preliminary outline of weekly topics is enclosed.

While we must conduct the course on a limited budget, we are able to offer an honorarium and will, of course, take care of all your expenses. We hope you will be able to accept our invitation and we are sure you will make a major contribution to our effort to examine this most important government office of the nation.
