Thank you for your letter bringing me up to date on your efforts to focus more attention on the POW/MIA issue.

Of great concern to me -- and to all Americans -- is the possibility that Americans may still be held captive in Indochina. I certainly have not forgotten these brave men who have made great sacrifices for their country. Last year, I sponsored legislation for National POW/MIA Recognition Day. To further raise public consciousness on the issue of our missing Americans, I was pleased to get legislation enacted to have the POW/MIA flag permanently displayed in the Capitol rotunda until a satisfactory accounting of our Vietnam POW/MIAs has taken place.

Again, thank you for writing. I would appreciate it if you would keep me apprised of your ongoing activities on behalf of our missing men.
