 1. (S) Bulk agent CS has been employed successfully in SVN

to contaminate areas and create temporary obstacles. The use of CS appears advisable in a contamination role to extend the denial period of selected interdiction points in Laos.

2. (S) Tests at Eglin Air Force Base utilizing bulk CS delivered in napalm tanks have contaminated areas for periods of up to 72 hours. This technique employed in the road denial program in Laos should extend the time required to repair choke points and develop profitable targets.

3. (S) Ambassador Sullivan's approval has been requested for the use of CS in those areas of Laos approved for air operations. (See REFERENCE.)

4. (S) Request CINCPAC approval to conduct air operations in Laos utilizing riot control agent CS.
