TO: ALL SPECIAL OVERSIGHT BOARD MEMBERS

After Senator Rudman's approval, we are scheduling an oversight board "hearing" in San Antonio, Texas on April 22, 1999

We are in the initial stages of planning right now. We do not envision this hearing being a "full board" meeting, and are prepared to run the session (which we think will be an evening (6pm to 10pm) session) NOT as an official meeting. Depending on the number of Board members attending, it may or may not be "official"

The purpose will be to solicit testimony from those who wish to address the board, with the intention of soliciting information that may be first hand knowledge of gulf war chemical biological incidents, etc.; we may hear from researchers as well. In any case, the agenda will be limited and the board members will most likely be in a "receive" mode. I do NOT envision requiring OSAGWI's attendance at the meeting.
