Just a note to say that Bud Zumwalt phoned me early yesterday morning to say that he had talked with Admiral Chon, our counterpart Vietnamese CNO about Le Quang Ni.

Admiral Chon was released from the camps about two years ago due to some extraordinary intervention but was not permitted to leave the country until several months ago as I understand it. In regard to Le Quang Ni, Chon said that he had died about a year ago from natural causes in Texas; he did not have the address of his surviving spouse. This information is probably more than TAN will be able to provide...so, unless you would like me to further pursue the matter, I will consider it closed.

Dee and I are becoming very excited about Tan and his family (eight in all) arriving within the next six months.
