Dear Admiral Zumwalt,

I am happy to inform you that the Thai Government has finally allowed us to be processed for resettlement in third countries. In fact, on the twenty-fourth of last month, we were moved to Phanat Nikhom, a Refugee camp inside Thailand, where interviews for resettlement can soon be conducted. Life in this new camp is all right, except that it is overly crowded.

I take this opportunity to express my sincere thanks to you for your prime effort in helping me immigrate into the United States. With a ready file in the American Embassy in Bangkok and high recommendations from you as well as from Dr. Pursel and Secretary Armitage, I am confident that the day when we can personally pay tribute to you and your family is no longer far away.
