Dear Uncle Bud,

Thank you very much for your concern about my wife's sister named DINH, 68 years old and her husband THU, 71, to come to the U.S.

For the problem presently, we need to know that :

1. Presently, DINH & THU have their 3 own children living in West Germany :

One daughter, LAN, 40, with her husband and 3 kids.

Two sons, HUNG, 35 and HONG, 21, both already finished their University studyings and are looking for jobs.

In 1980, HUNG had applied request for his parents to come living with him but West Germany Authorities rejected his application. They said it was late.

Then HUNG wrote to my wife asking her to sponsor his parents.

2. Recently, DINH & THU wrote to us telling that they both had been interviewed by the United Nations High Commissioner For Refugees (UNHCR) in Saigon. During the interview, DINH & THU declared that they are having their 3 own children living in West Germany. Their children had sent request to Authorities of this country to admit DINH & THU to live with them in this country but their request had been refused.

3. Now, it seems that UNHCR is hesitating either to send DINH & THU to the U.S. Or to make arrangement to admit them to West Germany with their children.

I think your assistance for this problem has been completed. We worry nothing and just wait for decision from UNHCR.

NGUYEN THI DINH AND SPOUSE (2 PERSONS) HAVE BEEN PLACED BY THE VIETNAMESE AUTHORITIES ON A LIST OF PERSONS FOR POSSIBLE FUTURE INTERVIEW IN HO CHI MINH CITY BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES (UNHCR). AT SOME POINT, THE VIETNAMESE AUTHORITIES WILL BE SENDING THEM A CARD WITH THE EXACT DATE AND TIME OF THE UNHCR INTERVIEW. WE CANNOT PREDICT WHEN THIS MIGHT BE, AS IT IS A PROCESS CONTROLLED ENTIRELY BY THE VIETNAMESE AUTHORITIES. NEITHER THIS EMBASSY NOR THE UNHCR REPRESENTATIVE IN HO CHI MINH CITY HAS ANY MEANS OF INFLUENCING THE DECISION OF THE VIETNAMESE AUTHORITIES CONCERNING THIS STEP.

2. WE NEED A COMPLETE, UPDATED, ORIGINAL, NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT (FORM I-134) ON BEHALF OF EACH OF YOUR RELATIVES IN VIETNAM WHOM YOU INTEND TO SPONSOR AND WHO WILL BE INTERVIEWED. YOUR PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED AFFIDAVITS OF SUPPORT NEED TO BE UPDATED ANNUALLY. THERE ARE TWO FORMS I-134 IN CIRCULATION: YOU SHOULD USE THE 1980 OR 1982 REVISION. WE REQUIRE ONE FORM FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL BEING SPONSORED. THESE FORMS MUST, REPEAT MUST, BE ACCOMPANIED BY EVIDENCE OF YOUR FINANCIAL RESOURCES, INCLUDING STATEMENTS FROM YOUR BANK AND EMPLOYER OR A NOTARIZED COPY OF

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YOUR MOST RECENT INCOME TAX RETURN IF YOU ARE
SELF-EMPLOYED.

NUMBERS.
