Admiral Zumwalt. Dr. Reckner sent us this e-mail this morning regarding your schedule. Please compare it with your own schedule.

Dear Priscilla:

Sorry I have been so difficult to contact the last couple of days, but I seem to have been in constant motion.

I will attach the Admiral's schedule to this message. In essence, there are no commitments for breakfast on Friday or Saturday. Also, there are no head tables for lunches or the banquet, so we could arrange for the Admiral to dine with whomever he wishes without sitting in front of everyone.

For Thursday night, I have changed the program, for us to have dinner at the County Line Restaurant. The whole gang will be there, but I will have a separate table for Adm. & Mrs. Zumwalt, Vadm. & Mrs. Tidd, Ambassador Sally Shelton-Colby, Capt. & Mrs. Jerry Wages, and Middy and me.

I just received a call a few minutes ago from Jerry Wages that he had reached Lubbock and was in his hotel; however, he had been having chest pains, and on the advice of his physician, was going to the emergency room of the University Medical Center. I will try to keep you abreast of developments there, but I will be out of the office and away from home from before sunrise tomorrow, so might be slow in reporting.

Concerning interviews with Les Cullen, I think the most convenient times, with a view to the conference program, would be either during the morning or afternoon sessions on Saturday. I have scheduled the Admiral to call on the Chancellor of the University at 2:30 p.m. on Friday, so that will pretty much break up the afternoon. At the same time, he is participating in the VIP panel on Friday morning. C-Span and also the ABC affiliate from Dallas will be covering the panel on which the Admiral will appear.

I believe we pretty much have everything in hand here right now. I will be at the airport tomorrow evening to meet the Admiral and Mrs. Zumwalt.
