- 2/13/44 "Lt(jg) Elmo R. Zumwalt U.S.N. reported aboard for duty on this vessel."
- 5/29/44 Underway with USS ROCKY MOUNT, LEONARD WOOD, CALVERT.
- 7/1/44 ERZ promoted to Lieutenant.
- 9/9/45 "1345 - Boarding party consisting of five officers and eleven enlisted men departed in charge of Lieutenant Elmo R. ZUMWALT, USN to board surrendered Japanese landing craft transport #144."
"2105 - Prize crew left the ship to man captured enemy vessel Elmo R. ZUMWALT, Lieutenant USN in charge."
- 9/11/45 "Lieutenant Elmo R. ZUMWALT and prize crew from this vessel are aboard the Japanese landing ship transport #144 anchored bearing 230T, distance 1000 yds. from this vessel."
"1533 - Prize crew Elmo R. ZUMWALT, Lieutenant USN in charge returned aboard."
- 9/12/45 "1146 - Received prize crew of 12 men and 4 officers from U.S.S. NASHVILLE (CL 43) via breeches buoy for use aboard surrendered enemy vessels."
- 9/13/45 "Lieutenant ZUMWALT and prize crew from this vessel are on board Japanese Gunboat ATAKA anchored on bearing 212T, distance 1000 yds. from this vessel."
- 9/15/45 "1130 - Japanese gunboat ATAKA with ROBINSON prize crew returned to anchorage."
- 9/18/45 Anchored. "Three surrendered Japanese vessels and one Chinese Navy Gunboat present."
- 9/25/45 Moored. "1245 - The following named officers returned aboard with six (6) men of the prize crew of the HIJMS ATAKA: Ensign F. M. LALOR, 389745, USN and Ensign C. B. STEPHENSON, 390038, USN."
- 10/13/45 "BECKMAN, Thomas W., QM2c(T), USNR returned aboard, having completed temporary duty on H.I.J.M.S. ATAKA prize crew, LIM, Lew F., Slc, USNR returned aboard having completed temporary duty on H.I.J.M.S. ATAKA prize crew."
- 10/24/45 "Lt. Elmo R. ZUMWALT, Jr. USN was detached to report to U.S.S. SAUFLEY (DD465)."
