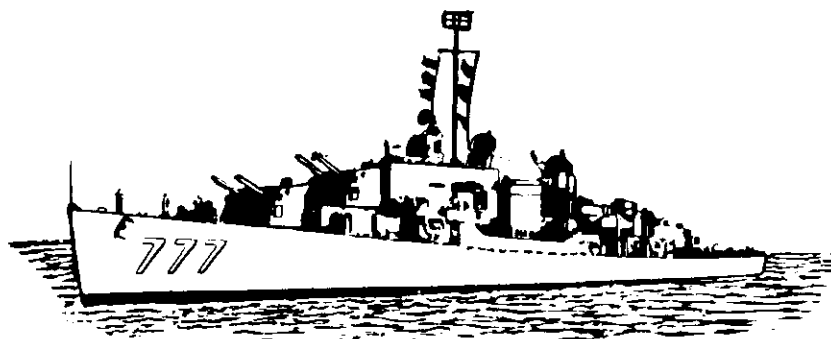

BOEING 747/767 PLANT TOUR
Friday, September 29th

Tour the Boeing 747 and 767 aircraft assembly plant, located on a 773-acre site in Everett, 25 miles north of Seattle. The main factory is the most modern aircraft manufacturing facility of its kind. The structure is the largest building, by volume, in the world. There can be as many as eight 747's and 767's in final assembly in the factory at the same time.

After viewing a film and slide presentation about the past, present and future of this high-tech leader, you will be taken to an observation platform to see the actual construction of the planes. End the tour with a drive down the flight line to see the final product close-up.

Experience the "Museum of Flight". Phase I, the "Red Barn", tells the story of early flight up to the mid-1930's. Phase II, the "Great Gallery" continues the story from the mid-1930's to the present. Approximately 45 aircraft, spacecraft and other large artifacts will be displayed, including an outdoor display accommodating other large aircraft. The main gallery is of a steel-and-glass, clear span construction and rises six stories at its highest (west) point. your return trip will be via West Seattle where you will view the beautiful skyline of Seattle..

The final stop of the day is at the Snoqualmie Winery. Enjoy this quaint and scenic winery as the day comes to an end!
