Dear Admiral Zumwalt:

From Wednesday, 28 April, through Friday morning, 30 April, military and civilian leaders will gather for the Naval Institute's 119th Annual Meeting and Third Annapolis Seminar at the U.S. Naval Academy. Over the course of the two-and-a-half-day event, we will debate the Navy's new white paper, "...From the Sea," hot-button issues of jointness, and historical puzzles of Amelia Earhart's last days and the age of the USS Constellation.

Admiral Kelso will take questions from a panel of three experts in air, surface, and subsurface warfare; General Mundy, Admiral Owens, and General Hoar will make addresses. In addition, we are working with the new administration to secure a senior official to outline President Clinton's defense initiatives.

The Naval Institute's seminar program is a vital part of our mission as a forum for discussing new ideas involving the nation's military. Last year, General Colin Powell, William Buckley, Generals Horner, Mundy, and McCaffrey, and Admiral Kelso all came to Annapolis as speakers and panelists in this program.

As a long-time Naval Institute supporter, you may already be familiar with the authors and military leaders who write and are written about in Proceedings. The Annapolis Seminar offers an opportunity to ask them direct questions and to hear them challenge and be challenged by each other.
