Reel 1

Covers career of then - Lt. Elmo R. Zumwalt in the Far East from the Japanese surrender to his return home to U.S.A. from WW II. Shows Zumwalt aboard destroyer USS ROBINSON (DD 562), when she captures a Japanese gunboat and his voyage up the Yantze River to Shanghai to contact U.S. Admiral Milton E. Miles, ally of Chiang Kai-Shek. Contains rare footage of Shanghai at the time of transition from Japanese to National Chinese control, as well as the Japanese surrender aboard the battleship USS MISSOURI (BB 63) and the US 7th fleet arriving at Shanghai. Also includes scenes of Zumwalt's wedding and sailors USA homecoming in 1945.

- 0' ROLL: CS-1 Ballast Point (San Diego)
- 1) Series LSs MSs and CUs Admiral's Barge approaching then mooring to pier; CNO Zumwalt and entourage leaving the barge and being greeted by senior officers on the pier.
- 2) Stern shot of USS WHITE SANDS (ARD-20) which is moored portside to pier.
- 3) MSs CUs CNO Zumwalt making a tour of the USS POINT LOMA (AGDS-2)--moored to pier-- which includes a tour of topside facilities of DSRV TRIESTE II (DSV-1) where he administers the oath of enlistment to an enlisted man--DSV-1 is secured in the docking well of the mother ship (AGDS-2)
- 4) LS CUs and MSs CNO Zumwalt arriving by staff car, being greeted by ships officers, then boarding the USS DOLPHINS (AGSS-555); after completion of tour, CNO Zumwalt leaves via the ships brow, enters his staff car and departs the area.
- 5) ECU US flag and CNO flag hoisted on flag staff AGSS-555, which is moored.

Reel 1 (Cont'd)

- 379' ROLL: BD-1 SUBMARINE BASE, SAN DIEGO
  - 6) MSs CUs CNO Zumwalt arriving by staff car, boarding mother ship, then boarding DSRV TURTLE (DSV-3) which is secured aboard the mother ship; the CNO leaves by staff car after completion of the tour.
  - 7) MCU sign on building: RESCUE SYSTEM TEST FACILITY with logo.
  - 8) Sequence showing CNO Zumwalt arriving by staff car; after being briefed by senior officers, he boards DSRV-1--which is set up on blocks inside a building. After completion the CNO leaves DSRV-1, is further briefed by officers then departs by staff car.
  - 9) Various shots CNO Zumwalt being greeted and briefed by officers at the porpoise training facility; then given a demonstration of porpoise activity; after completion he boards an Admiral barge and departs. Lettering on the barge transom reads:
