RECRUIT TRAINING COMMANDS FILE WITHOUT ACTION

CIVILIAN CLOTHING ON NAVAL SHORE ESTABLISHMENTS

1. THROUGHOUT THE YEARS, THE NAVY HAS BEEN AWARE OF THE STYLES OF THE TIMES AND HAS ATTEMPTED TO BE RESPONSIVE TO THEM INSOFAR AS PRACTICABLE. AS A RULE THE NAVY FOLLOWS CIVILIAN CUSTOMS OF DRESS AND GROOMING EXCEPT WHERE THEY CONFLICT WITH SMART NEAT APPEARANCE OR WITH MILITARY DUTIES.
2. A RECENT SURVEY INDICATES LACK OF UNIFORMITY AMONG MANY SHORE ESTABLISHMENTS IN CIVILIAN CLOTHING REGULATIONS. IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN UNIFORMITY OF ACTION THROUGHOUT THE NAVAL ESTABLISHMENT, COMMANDING OFFICERS OF SHORE STATIONS WILL NORMALLY PERMIT ALL ENLISTED PERSONNEL TO WEAR CIVILIAN CLOTHING AT ALL BASE FACILITIES WHEN OFF DUTY OR OUTSIDE OF NORMAL WORKING HOURS. AS AN EXAMPLE, CIVILIAN CLOTHING SHOULD BE AUTHORIZED IN
